<b>WBCS Standard of Dress</b>	
Shirts	<p><u>Polo</u> Any Color, Long or Short Sleeves Modest fit and Appropriate size *No long-sleeved shirts under short-sleeved polos Do not need to be tucked in</p>
Pants	<p><u>Blue denim jeans</u> traditional, with no holes, frays, distressing, embellishments, no cargo or joggers, no extra baggy, no tight fitting, etc. Must be modest fit and appropriate size.</p> <p>Or</p> <p><u>Dress pants</u> or slacks with no pockets on the pant leg (cargo style), no joggers or cuffed ankles, Colors: Navy, Khaki, Grey, or Black Modest fit and appropriate size</p> <p>*Elastic waist allowed for K3-2nd grade only.</p>
Shorts ( <i>Boys</i> )	<p>Structured Style (golf shorts, uniform shorts) No cargo shorts 7 inch inseam or longer Colors: Navy, Khaki, Grey, or Black Modest fit and appropriate size</p>
Shorts ( <i>Girls</i> )	<p>Structured Style (bermuda shorts, uniform shorts), No cargo shorts 7 inch inseam or longer Modest fit and Appropriate size Colors: Navy, Khaki, Grey, or Black</p>

Belts	If needed but not mandatory. Solid black or brown only
Shoes	Closed toed shoes, No Flip flops, crocs, or sandals Athletic sandals are allowed when wearing shorts. (Athletic sandal examples: Teva, Chacos, Merrell, etc.)
Outerwear	(Outside) Students may wear appropriate coats or jackets (with or without hoods) to school. Once they reach the classroom or locker, these must be put away. (Indoors) Students may wear a hoodless quarter zip pullover or hoodless cardigan. Must be appropriate size *No blankets, hoodies, snuggies, wraps, etc. *No hooded garments allowed in the classrooms.

<b>Gym/PE</b>	
	Clean tennis shoes to change into on PE days to be kept at school at all times. (As soon as the new gym is open)  7th-12 grade students must wear black athletic shorts with a 7 inch inseam (or longer) or black athletic pants. No joggers, cotton sweatpants or sweat pant material. No sleeveless shirts.
<b>WBCS Chapel Attire</b> <i>(also Christmas and Easter Program Attire)</i>	
Girls	Dresses that touch the knee. No sleeveless. Or dress slacks/dress pants. No jeans and no colored jeans.

Boys	Collared polo or collared button-down dress shirt Dress pants. No jeans and no colored jeans.
<b>Fridays</b> ( <i>WBCS Spirit Wear option, all other standards of dress apply</i> )	
Shirts	WBCS Shirt or Bradford Spirit Wear Tops (Spirit Wear Hoodies are allowed on Fridays)
Pants	WBCS Spirit Wear Athletic Pants are allowed
<b>Dress-Up Week Attire</b>	
	Dress-up outfits must be modest No Sleeveless Regular standard of dress required if not participating.
<b>Field Trip Attire</b>	
	Blue denim jeans, traditional, with no holes, frays, distressing, embellishments, no cargo, joggers or cuffed ankles, no extra baggy, no tight fitting, etc. Must be modest fit and appropriate size.
<b>Track Meet Attire</b>	
	Current Year Bradford Shirt Black athletic shorts with a 7 inch inseam or longer

Deviation of the jeans policy as defined in the WBCS Standard of Dress above could result in the removal of the option to wear jeans.

A higher standard of dress encourages greater respect for individuals and results in a higher standard of behavior. WBCS reserves the right to make discretionary judgment regarding the appropriateness of student dress/attire not explicitly covered in this standard of dress policy. The final interpretation of this standard remains the responsibility of the administration.

Violations of this standard may result in the following, but not limited to: verbal warning, phone call to parent, and/or being sent home unexcused. WBCS will not tolerate repeated violations.
